## **Audio-Recording Agreement**

Under Subpart E of Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, a student with a qualifying disability that adversely affects his/her ability to take or read notes may be permitted to audio-record class lectures as a form of reasonable academic accommodation. Use of this accommodation is subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Recordings of lectures are only for the student's personal use in study and preparation related to the course.
- 2. The student may not share these recordings with any other person without the consent of the lecturer.
- 3. The student may not publish, quote, or post the lecture online or on social media without the written consent of the lecturer.
- 4. Instructors may limit the use of a recording device whenever **all students** are instructed not to take written or recorded notes.
- 5. The instructor should notify a guest presenter in advance if lectures are recorded for access accommodations and about the nature of the recording agreement.
- 6. Lecture recordings are not a replacement for required class attendance.
- 7. Recordings should be deleted at the end of the semester.
