#### NOTES

All courses will meet at the scheduled exam time to conduct final testing or to accomplish some other meaningful educational activity. The exam time counts toward the total instructional time for each course. Wednesday classes hold exams during the final (15<sup>th</sup>) meeting period because this 15<sup>th</sup> period completes the required total instructional time. Classes that meet more than three hours per week or do not fit into the regular class block schedule should use the earliest appropriate exam period.

No student will be required to take 3 exams on the same day. It is the student's responsibility to speak with the instructors involved and to request to move one of the exams to a time convenient for both the student and the instructor. Such alternate arrangements should be finalized no later than the Monday preceding exam week (April 27, 2026).

Any student with an emergency or extenuating circumstance must work with the Office of Academic Affairs to request modifications. Students cannot use travel arrangements as justification for requesting exam changes.

Any exceptions to the above schedule and policies must be approved by the appropriate Division Chair and the Vice President for Academic Affairs.
