Faculty Council- Faculty Council is formed by the election of 5 members: Each of the academic divisions shall elect a division member to serve as its representative on the Council; the Chairperson of the Faculty is elected by the full faculty. No faculty member may serve for more than two consecutive terms—four years. After two years off the Council, a former representative may be re-elected as a Council member. Terms on Faculty Council are for two years beginning the fall semester following the spring election.
